### ROAR LEADERSHIP CHANGE

Remotely Operated Auto Racers (ROAR) is formally announcing the official resignation of Mr. Rick Wilson as President of ROAR effective December 8, 2005. Mr. Wilson notified the Executive Committee (ExCom) of ROAR by e-mail of his intentions. This was also immediately publicly posted on the ROAR website. The ExCom has accepted Mr. Wilson's resignation and in accordance with the bylaws of the non-profit corporation, Mr. Mike Queller, Vice-President, has assumed the roles and responsibilities of the vacated position until presidential election in October 2006.

Mr. Wilson's much appreciated hard efforts and guidance through turbulent times in the R/C industry may never be fully recognized by every member. Prior to his three years as President he served as ExCom Promotions Director, Region 12 Director (ROAR's largest membership region), and was a contributing member to many of ROAR's online rules committees. Mr. Wilson cited increased intensity in his work schedule, his commitment to his family, and his lack of available time to provide the high level of commitment to ROAR needed for quality leadership as his primary reasons for his departure at this time. Mike Queller has served as ROAR Vice-President for six years and was recently re-elected to a fourth term. He has served on various ROAR committees, has officiated numerous national and international events, and is the current IFMAR Fuel Director. His racing experience includes electric and fuel classes and he has been a ROAR member for over thirty years. His vacated Vice-Presidential position will be filled by a designated appointee approved by the ExCom as outlined in the bylaws. Because of present matters requiring more urgency this decision, once made, will be made public at a later date.

ROAR is reassuring its membership that ROAR continues to be strong and that the ExCom will continue to work fervently for the well being of organized R/C model auto racing competition, both nationally and internationally. Thank you again to all of ROAR's volunteers with special gratitude to Mr. Rick Wilson.
