## Brushless Electronic Speed Control (ESC) Approval Form

Please complete the requested information below and submit it along with one ESC to be tested and certified as either a zero-timing ESC or as a programmable ESC with a compatible zero-timing mode. You must include any instructions, software, or hardware necessary to set or program the zero-timing mode in programmable ESCs.

- Approval dates will be listed as the date of delivery, assuming the product meets all the specifications in testing.
- All submissions need to be sent via a courier that provides tracking data.
- Approvals will remain in effect for 4 years provided the submitting manufacturer maintains its affiliate status continuously throughout that period. Failure to remain an affiliate in good-standing will cause all of the manufacturers products to be removed from the approved list and a fee of \$100 for each product seeking reinstatement after affiliate status is restored.
- ESCs can be submitted at any time, but they must be approved AND available at retail locations 30 days before a ROAR event to be used in competition.
- New software versions for programmable ESCs must be approved. Speed controls using software that is not approved will be deemed ineligible for competition and any results disqualified. ROAR will not consider or approve any software or firmware versions designated as "Beta."
- Any model ESC that has an unsubmitted, unapproved companion model that is indistinguishable by any means other than its label, will not qualify for approval.
- "All ESCs submitted for approval must comply with ROAR rules (see especially rule #7.3 and rule #11.3.5).

As a company principal, I certify that all the above information is accurate and that the ESC being submitted is a production unit, identical to those that will be available to the retail market and to team drivers. I understand that a violation of these rules will result in a minimum one-year suspension from all ROAR-sanctioned competitions.
